SUMMARY

This report and proposed motion summarises opposition by particularly the Lower Clarence Community to the Northern NSW Local Health District Board's consolidation of patients and staff of Maclean District Hospital into one hospital ward.

PROPOSED MOTION

That Council notifies the Premier of NSW the Hon. Gladys Berejiklian, Member for Clarence the Hon. Chris Gulaptis, the Northern NSW Local Health District Board of Directors and the NSW Local Health District Chief Executive, Wayne Jones, the NSW State Government opposition leader the Hon. Jodi McKay and opposition duty officer for Clarence the Hon. Adam Searle, of this Council's strong opposition to the District Health Board's consolidation of patients and staff into one ward at Maclean District Hospital.

BACKGROUND

The community became aware of this issue when the Northern NSW Local Health District Board's release of a one page *Community Information* A4 size sheet of 30 lines in seven questions and answers format dated 13 February 2020, to hospital employees. The NSW Nurses and Midwives Association and the NSW Health Services Union arranged a public meeting for Thursday, 27 February 2020, which filled to overflowing the Jim Thompson Pavilion at Maclean Showground. Northern NSW Local Health District seemingly belatedly also hosted a meeting for hospital staff and the community on Wednesday 26 February.

Council had received no information or had any contact from the Northern NSW Local Health Board, nor anyone else regarding the consolidation of the hospital wards. In effect closure of Ward 2 albeit the Northern NSW Local Health District Board maintains it is a hospital ward reconfiguration and consolidation of patients and staff into one ward while the other ward will remain available for surge capacity.

KEY ISSUES

The Community Information sheet includes a question Are beds closing at Maclean District Hospital and the answer No. We are consolidating patients and staff into one ward, while the other ward will remain available for surge capacity in times of peak activity. Fact is the number of beds is now substantially below that at points in time in previous years.

Population of the Lower Clarence continues to increase, there are substantial developments under construction and also pending approval, holiday parks have heavy bookings during holiday periods and weekends. Off ramps from the new motorway are at Maclean's entrances.

There have been significant improvements to Maclean District Hospital wards in recent years such as additional bathrooms to the second ward plus the construction of a new larger helipad at the hospital. The "reconfiguration" has a lot of opposition in the Lower Clarence Community.

The Hospital Auxiliary has raised a lot of money for equipment at the hospital and I understand currently has fundraised \$140,000 to date for purchase of another item of equipment for the hospital.

BACKGROUND

The date for the 2020 Maclean show was advised in 2018 by the Maclean Show Society as 20 May 2020. Council resolution 15.182/18 of 16 October 2018 resolved that Council apply to the NSW Treasury (Industrial Relations) for approval for a part-day local public holiday for this date. Subsequently, approval was granted and Public Holidays Amendment Order 2018 gazetted 21 December 2018.

The date applied for in late 2018 is no longer consistent with the current 2020 Maclean Show scheduled to be conducted 28-29 April 2020.
